HANDS ON COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Cracked Tooth Diagnosis and Protective Preparations

DR. DAVID CLARK

Cracked and fractured teeth remain the third leading cause of tooth loss. Misdiagnosis is common. In this session David will share diagnosis based on low, medium, and high-risk enamel cracks. Then attendees will prepare models with several different overlay preparations based off actual clinical cases. Attendees will be able to keep the models as a reference. Each time we restore the surface of a posterior tooth; design comes into play. Traditional cavity preparations that we learned in the past handicap our thinking and must be reversed. In addition, when we are re-treating a legacy Class I or Class II restoration, we are unwittingly inheriting adverse engineering that must be corrected.

Learn and perform:

- Preps for cracked virgin teeth
- Decision making tree for Calla Lilly vs. Flattened Call Lilly vs. Cuspal Overlay
- When to do endo and when to extract

Advanced Posterior

DR. RAFAEL BUSTAMANTE

The Bioclear Method is highly effective for addressing restorative challenges in posterior teeth by leveraging its unique approach to tooth preparations that take into consideration the physical properties of composite resin. In this workshop, we will be extrapolating what we know to create temporary or permanent composite structures to effectively and efficiently restore badly damaged posterior teeth.

Learning Objectives:

- Applying the root overlay technique to provide structural support to matrices.
- Creating unilateral contacts with the direct contact strut.
- Systematic reduction of injection overmolded composite to recreate cusps, particularly those that need to have aesthetic appeal.

Bioclear for Primary Teeth

This one of a kind course was designed specifically for Pediatric Dentists or General Dentists who treat children in their scope of practice. The Bioclear restoration for the permanent dentition is best described with the acronym ICE: Infinity Edge, Compression based, and Enamel driven. After multiple studies and decades of clinical success, it is a proven model.

Smile Design: “OK” to “WOW” – Mastering Shaping, Discing, & Polishing

Have you ever completed an anterior case only to feel it's missing that “wow” factor? Perhaps you sense something is off but can't quite pinpoint it. This course is designed to bridge the gap between “good enough” and exceptional by teaching you how to identify and incorporate the critical elements of tooth morphology that are often overlooked when performing direct Bioclear veneers. Gain the confidence and skills to elevate your cases and create results you can truly take pride in.

- Apply smile design concepts to a provided model, improving aesthetics through shaping, discing, and polishing.
- Refine incisal embrasures and incorporate them into your model.

Problem Solving: Snap-off Treatment with Bioclear

Join Dr. Dan Henriksen for this exciting new heroic dental modality. In the past when an incisor snapped off at or near tissue level, we had very few options, usually extraction and implant. The Bioclear method, used to its fullest along with some cool tricks, can predictably “save the day” for the patient. And you feel like a Rock Star!

- Learn the strut/tross technique to create the framework for bilateral contact construction

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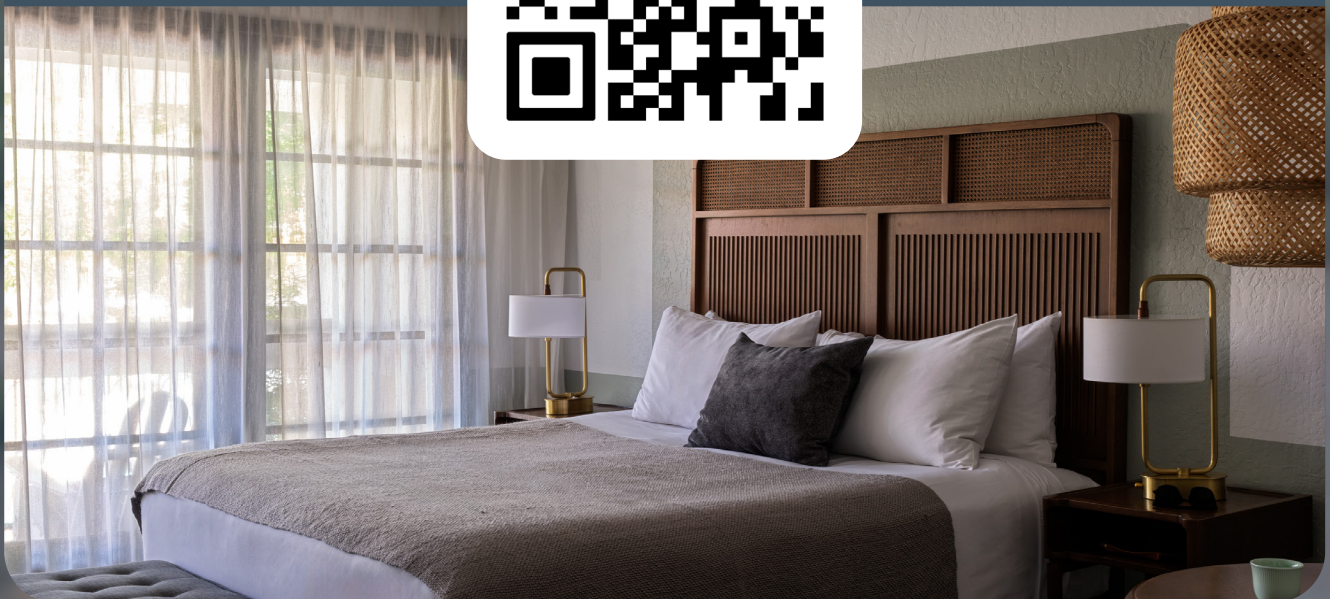
